Thankfulness and praise

Girls Home: Although we have a long ways to go, funds have been coming in! And we thank and praise God for your generous donations. As you are putting together your Christmas list, please consider a gift toward this lifesaving project. A gift of any amount — \$1, \$5, \$10 — or whatever God leads you to give will make a significant difference.

COVID-19: Good Samaritan, a school in Uganda with a capacity of 2,500 students, was able to be COVID-19 compliant thanks to JHC's donors.

Self-sustainability: Because of the

generosity of so many, Good Samaritan School was able to purchase 200 acres of farmland to expand their food source, care for the children and cover operational expenses for the campus.

Vehicle for evangelism: We thank the Lord for providing a vehicle to facilitate the ministry of evangelism in the mountains of western Uganda with Pastor Frank.

COVID-19 food assistance and Bible distribution: From Central Asia to Uganda and Central African Republic, your donations have made it possible to provide food assistance during this lockdown. JHC partnered with local churches and others to help widows, shut-ins and single mothers who were in desperate need of food.
